

Checklist for Searching Parents: When You Think Your Child Has Been Parentally Abducted

Keep this checklist in a secure location.

If your child is missing and you believe they have been abducted by their other parent, you should immediately report your child missing to the police.

When you speak with police, be prepared to provide a photograph and description of your child and of the alleged abducting parent, as well as any information you have about where they were last seen. Make sure to explain your specific concerns and why you believe it is an abduction rather than a custody and access issue.
